ABSTRACT

Thundikeri compared with tonsilitis mentioned by susrutha in talugata roga and Vagbhatacharya in kanta roga. The recurrent attack of tonsilitis make disease chronic and timely treatment is essential. The conventional line of treatment of thundikeri includes use of antibiotics and tonsillectomy. To over come this we have pratisaraniya kshara karma. Kshara has the property of bedana and lekana and help to reduce the inflammation.

INTRODUCTION

Tonsilitis, or inflammation of tonsils is a common disease which effects the children and young people and make up 1.3% of opd visits. It is predominantly result of a viral or bacterial infection. In acute tonsilitis patient may suffer sore throat, fever, dysphagia. Repeated occurrences may lead to chronic tonsilitis which impact severly on patient's life. Chronic tonsilitis may be a complication of acute tonsilitis. Pathologically, micro abscess walled off by fibrous tiuressue have been seen in lymphoid follicles of tonsils.

Thundikeri is one among urdha jatrugata roga mentioned by Susrutha in talugata roga and Vagbhatacharya in kanta roga. Susrutha mentioned that it is due to vitiation of kapha raktha and resembles karpasa phala situated at talu. It is a bhedyā Sadhya roga and drugs like shothahara, kapha raktha hara, Vedana hara can be used for its treatment.

DISCUSSION

The word meaning of pratisarana is gharsana/rubbing. Here pratisarana of palasa kshara is performed over tonsils..

Palasha -lekhana, shodha hara, kapha -raktha hara

Ksharaneeya Dravya and lekhan property-act as chemical cauterizing agent over tonsils.

Chedana, bhedana-size of tonsils decrease.

Ushna guna-minute burns and coagulation of micro lymphoid tissues, reduces intra cellular space and aggregates lymphoid tissue and reduce the size of tonsils.

RESULT

Complete reduction in size of enlarged tonsils was observed on 2nd day. Along with pain, irritation of throat also reduced. With a follow up period of 6 months patient didn't had even a single time sore throat.

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
