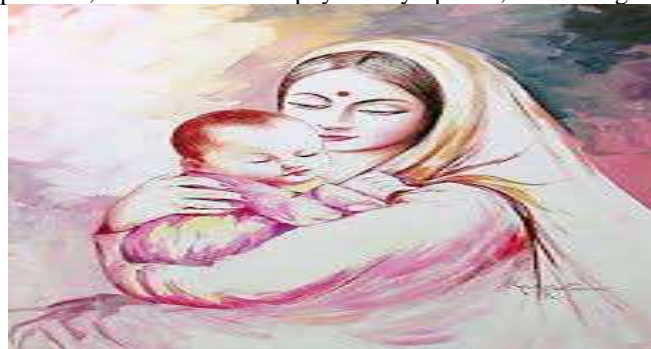
ABSTRACT
