



# SAHAPANA AND ANUPANA ACCORDING TO RASENDRA SAMBHAVA: A REVIEW ARTICLE

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## ABSTRACT

Ayurveda is the only science that deals with the importance in Aushada sevana kala, Matra; etc as per Roga-Rogi bala and various other factors. While explaining each disease condition, various acharyas including brihathreyes and laghuthreyes deals with explanation on Anupana that should be with the medicine. The referencing for Anupana can be spotted in various classics but the detailing about Sahapana is very less. Textbooks of Rasasastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana, such as Rasa Tarangini contains Sahapana reference. But the detailed adhyaya of Sahapana is seen in Rasendra Sambhava, a combined textbook. Here, acharya have dedicated an entire chapter on Sahapana and Anupana where, individual Sahapana and Anupana is been mentioned for different conditions. The article is an effort to list down all the Anupana and Sahapana mentioned in Rasendra Sambhava with the respective disease.

## INTRODUCTION

### Rasendra Sambhava

The textbook *Rasendra Sambhava* is a combined textbook containing references from *Charaka Samhita*, *Susrutha Samhitha*, *Astangahridhaya*, *Dhanwantari Nigahantu*, *Harita Samhita*, *Gadanigraha*, *Bhela Samhita*, *Bhavaprakasha Nighantu*, *Vangasena*, *Yogaratanakara*, *Yogatarangini*, *Yogachinthamanai*, *Bhaishajya Ratnavali*, *Sharangadhara Samhita*, *Chakradatta*, *Rasarnava*, *Rasa Hridaya Tantra*, *Rasa Ratna Sammucchaya*, *Rasaratanakara*, *Rasapradeepika*, *Rasachandamshu*, *Rasakamadenu*, *Rasatantrasara*, *Rasaendramangala*, *Rasakuthuhala*, *Rasendra Sara Sangraha*, *Rasa Yoga Sagara*, *Rasa Raja Sundhara*, *Rasa Tarangini*, *Rasamanjari*, *Rasayanasaras*; etc. The textbook contains 5 *Patalas*. First *patala* deals with *Paribhasha*; etc, second *patala* contains detailing on *Dravya shodhanamarana* and its *gunas*, *dosha shanthi*, third *patala* contains *Rasayogas* as per *Roga* and forth *patala* deals with *Kupipakwa rasayana*, *Parpati nirmana* and *Loha yogas* as per diseases. The fifth *Patala* is exclusively dedicated to *Sahapana* and *Anupana* as per various conditions.

### Sahapana and Anupana<sup>[1]</sup>

*Sahapana*; that which is taken along with the medicine can be *Dravya*, *swarasa* or milk or anything that has the *yogavahi*

### Synergic action of Adjuvants

Adjuvants, derived from the Latin word “adjuvare” meaning “to help”. “Substance used in combination with a specific antigen that produced a more robust immune response than an antigen alone”. The synergic effect of *Anupana* and *Sahapana* is proven in many articles. The findings confirm that the combination of drugs can enhance the effect, greater than the predicted potency when used as a single drug. The

*guna*. Whereas, the *Anupana* is taken after the intake of the medicinal drug and it increases the potency of the medicine administrated. *Sahapana* action is compared with a simile where in how an oil drop spreads over the water surface, *Sahapana* also takes the medicine into all parts of the body. *Doshayuktha* or *Guru Dravya* or medicine in more quantity can be administrated along with a suitable *Anupana* in right dose. The *Anupana* administrated will be endowed with taste, does *Brimhana* to the body, act as *Vrishya*, does *Doshashamana*, imparts *Tripti*, *Tarpana*, *Sukham*, *Mardhava*, *Deepana*, *Bala* and *Varnakaraka*, does *Dosha Shamana* and act as *Chedana*. It is also effective in *Srama* and *Brama*.

*Anupana Dravyas* mentioned in *Rasendra Sambhava* are; *Dravya*, *swarasa*, *kwatha*, *churna*, *avaleha*, *asava*, *sura*, *madhu*, *ksheera*, *phala* or *jala*

In *Anupana abhava*; with due consideration to *vyadhi* and *kala*, *mahendratoya* can be given. In *Vata-kaphaja* condition; hot water is advised and in *Pittaja* condition; cold water is given. For *Sahapana*; the *rasa* told under particular *Rogadhikara* can be given along with the medicine, and later on *Anupana* can be given. The *Anupana patra* here told should be *Shatroktha patra*, else one can use mud pot. Mud pots are considered as *Subha* and *Uttama*.

synergic action allows the use of lower dose combination constituents, and may reduce the adverse drug reaction<sup>[2]</sup>. Synergistic combination of two or more agents can overcome toxicity and other side effects associated with high dose of single drug. Therapeutically promising multi-target effect<sup>[3]</sup>. Combinatory treatment may achieve more stable “network response” than single drugs. Single drug treatments are less effective than drug combinations in complex treatment regimes<sup>[4]</sup>.

## CONCLUSION

Just like *Anupana*, *Sahapana* also play avital role in potentiating the drug action both through pharmacodynamics and pharmaco-kinetics. The selection of *Sahapana* depends on the *Roga-Rogi Bala* and *avastha*, a single formulation can be administrated with different *Sahapana* as per the condition. This completely depends on the physicians *Yukthi* and *Roga-Rogi avastha*. More than just acting as a vehicle and improving palatability and ease of administration; *Sahapana* also have role in intervene in drug action, metabolism of drug inside the body, drug absorbtion, in controlling adverse drug reaction and site-specific action.

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
