Data Collection Method

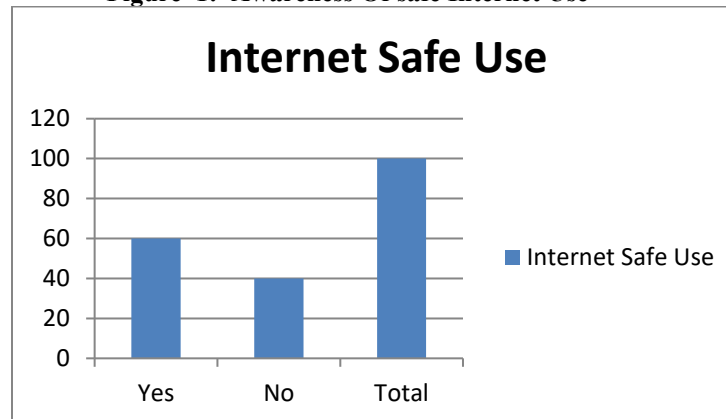

Figure 1: Awareness Of safe Internet Use

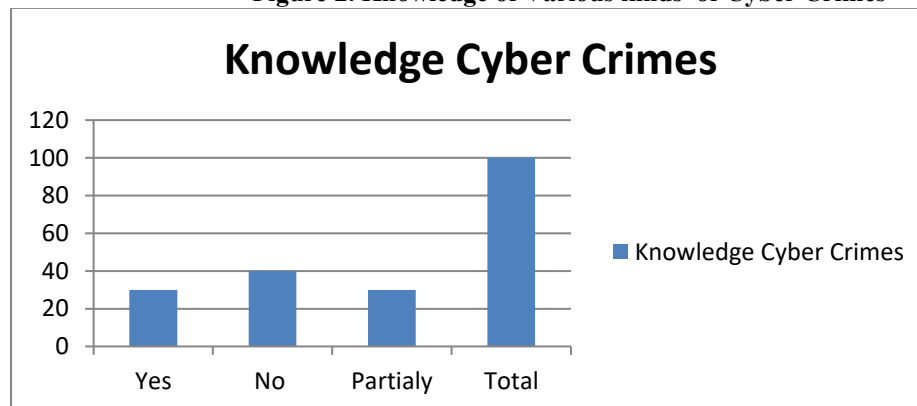
**Interpretation**

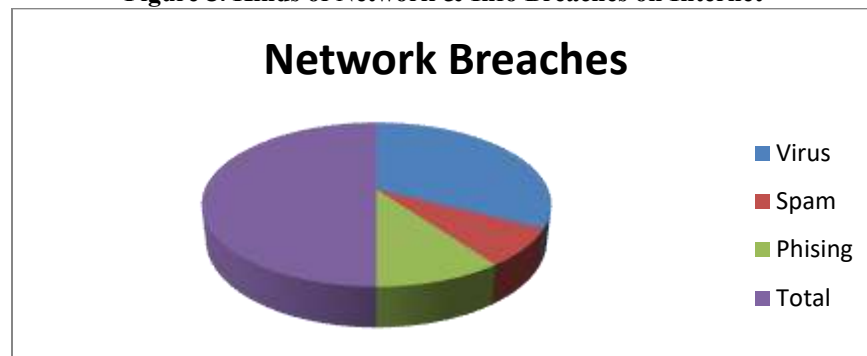
Figure 2: Knowledge of Various kinds of Cyber Crimes

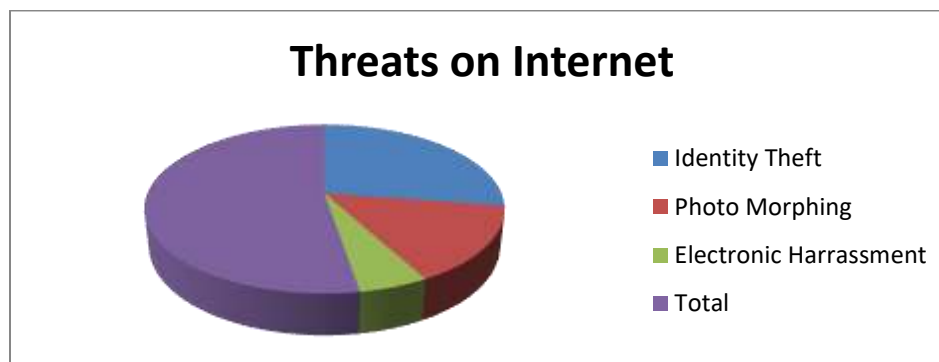
Figure 3: Kinds of Network & Info Breaches on Internet
